ISSF DIRECTOR'S CHARTER

It is the purpose of this Charter to provide Pistol Australia (PA) with the rules governing the information and management roles for the position of ISSF Director.

- 1. Name:** ISSF Director.
- 2. Objective:** To revitalise and expand ISSF shooting throughout Australia. To encourage club, state and national level competition amongst ISSF shooters.
- 3. Position:** The Directorship will be elected for a period of two (2) years.

The position of Director shall be determined by election at the Annual General Meeting of Pistol Australia Inc. Nominations will be accepted from any member of PA.

Proposals for amendments to Regulations for the operations of ISSF shooting must be submitted to the Management Committee for consideration and ratification.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Aim:** To achieve the objective set out in the Charter for the ISSF Director by:
 - 1.01** Promoting the enjoyment of ISSF shooting by PA members and developing strategies for the encouragement of new shooters in the ISSF discipline.
 - 1.02** Revitalising, expanding and promoting the discipline of ISSF pistol shooting to PA members and the community, particularly through the shooting media and competitions at club, state and national level.
 - 1.03** Planning, developing and assessing increased activity and participation in ISSF pistol shooting.
 - 1.04** Ensuring that where practicable, and taking into account constraints imposed by location, available facilities and personnel, that PA shooters comply with international practices/standards.
 - 1.05** Liaising with State ISSF Directors to ensure a consistency of approach in ISSF activities among all PA members.

2. Management:

The Director shall be responsible for:

- 2.01** Liaising with, and encouraging State Associations and Directors to develop and actively promote ISSF pistol shooting.
- 2.02** Recommending and developing guidelines for the appropriate conduct of National ISSF Championships.
- 2.03** Consulting with the NRC on the implementation of changes and interpretations to the rules as promulgated by the ISSF.
- 2.04** Consulting with the NRC and the NCC on the implementation of officiating and coaching programmes appropriate to the ISSF disciplines.
- 2.05** Submitting timely reports on ISSF pistol shooting activities to PA Management and to the *Australian Pistol Shooters' Bulletin*.
- 2.06** In conjunction with the PA Treasurer submit an annual budget for the activities of the ISSF Director.
- 2.07** Maintaining the approved budget and reporting any relevant findings to PA Management in a timely manner.
- 2.08** Preparing an annual report on ISSF pistol shooting activities and submitting to PA Management before the PA Annual General Meeting.
- 2.09** Carrying out such matters or activities conducive to or incidental to ISSF pistol shooting as directed by PA Management.

3. Miscellaneous:

Amendment to these Regulations will be by way of recommendation to PA Management Committee.
