2011 METALLIC SILHOUETTE TEAM SELECTION CRITERIA

Nomination for PA National Team selection

Pistol Australia (PA) members intending to seek consideration for selection to the 2011 Australian Metallic Silhouette team(s) are required to submit a nomination form, which is available on request from the PA Sports Administrator or can be downloaded from the PA website at www.pistol.org.au/Comps/SelectionCriteria.php. Nomination forms must be submitted prior to or with the first score nominated. In 2011 Pistol Australia will select two (2) Australian Metallic Silhouette teams, a Big Bore and a Small Bore team. A Metallic Silhouette Field Pistol team will be selected from the members of the Metallic Silhouette Big Bore and the Metallic Silhouette Small Bore teams.

Qualification Requirements

To qualify for the 2011 Australian Metallic Silhouette team selection, competitors must submit a minimum of three (3) PA sanctioned "Open" competition match scores plus the National Championships score in the qualifying period and obtain a minimum qualifying aggregate of the four (4) match scores of:

Big Bore	560
Small Bore	540
Field Pistol	260

The 2011 Metallic Silhouette Team qualifying period begins on 1 January 2010 and concludes on 31 December 2010. **Participation in the Pistol Australia National Championship is compulsory.** Scores shot at the 2010 IMSSU World Championships are eligible for nomination.

Selection

The aggregate of the three (3) best four (4) match scores, plus the score shot at the Pistol Australia National Championships will determine team selection. The score shot at the National Championships will be used to break a tied aggregate score.

Scores must be endorsed by the officiating Pistol Australia Judge in attendance at the competition. It is the shooter's responsibility to submit his / her scores within three (3) weeks of the competition to the National Metallic Silhouette Director and a copy to the PA office. Scores shot on or around the final date must be submitted within five (5) working days of the final competition. **The deadline date for final submission of scores is 7 January 2011.**

The Field Pistol Team will be selected from members of the Big Bore and / or Small Bore Teams. Any one shooter may be selected to more than one team.

Acceptance of a Position on the Team

Offers of a position on the 2010 Australian Metallic Silhouette Team will be made by PA subsequent to PA selection and the approval of Australian International Shooting Limited. Acceptance of such offers must be made in writing within 14 days of the offer and must accompany a completed, signed PA Team Agreement plus a team member contribution as per the PA policy current at the time of the relevant International competition.

In the event that no response is received by PA within the 14 days or the offer is declined, the position will be offered to the next ranked shooter(s), until all positions are filled or there are no qualifiers remaining.
