Conditions of entry

1. Entrants must be current financial members of Pistol Australia (PA) and present a current holster card at registration
2. By submitting this entry form you are declaring you are a current financial member of PA
3. Late entries will be accepted after closing and are subject to a late entry fee *Note: Squadding times may be inconvenient*
4. Competitors' ammunition will be tested for power factor
5. Suitable eye and ear protection and enclosed footwear is mandatory
6. All competitor guns must be presented for gun check prior to commencement of competition
7. NRA Action Pistol Shooting Rules, effective January 2020, subsequent amendments and PA requirements will apply
8. Ties will be decided by shoot-off. Rule 15.2.
9. Competitors will be requested to assist with range duties
10. Semi Jacketed projectiles are permitted. FMJ or projectiles that appear to be FMJ are not permitted
11. COVID-19 safe range precautions required by ACT Government will be adhered to
12. Use of face masks may be required in any designated indoor area
13. Check in CBR QR posters will be displayed and registration compulsory for all competitors over the age of 16
14. SSAA COVID-19 safe range requirements will be displayed on the days of competition
15. Metallic and Production matches are planned to be held on Saturday – subject to number of entries received
16. Open and Prod optics matches are planned to be held on Sunday – subject to number of entries received
