



TARGET PISTOL AUSTRALIA 2026 CMP WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Target Pistol Australia (TPA) may select athletes to represent Australia in the 2026 CMP World Championships to be held at Toowoomba Pistol Club from 26th to 30th October 2026. Selection will be conducted on an event-by-event basis for all CMP World Championships competitions. Athletes may be selected in more than one competition, subject to any entry limits or conditions imposed by the event organisers.

1. **Nomination for TPA National Team selection**

- a. TPA members intending to seek consideration for selection to the 2026 CMP World Championships are required to submit an official TPA Team Nomination Form at least 60 days prior to the 2026 TPA Action Pistol World Championships.
- b. The Team Nomination Form is available on request from the TPA Sports Administrator or can be downloaded from the TPA website at <http://www.pistol.org.au/selection-criteria>.
- c. In the event that a nominee who has been selected to a Target Pistol Australia team has subsequently declined that selection and attended and competed either as an individual or for another organisation at the same competition, the Target Pistol Australia Board may, at its absolute discretion, exclude that nominee from consideration for future teams.

2. **Qualification Event**

The qualification event for selection to the 2026 CMP World Championships is the 2026 TPA Action Pistol World Championships, to be held at Toowoomba Pistol Club from 20th to 24th October 2026.

3. **Qualification Requirements**

To qualify for selection, competitors must be current financial members of TPA, submit a TPA Team Nomination Form in accordance with clause 1, and compete in the corresponding event at the 2026 TPA Action Pistol National Championships.

Selection to each CMP World Championships competition will be based only on the competitor's official result in the same event at the 2026 TPA Action Pistol National Championships.

For the avoidance of doubt, a result achieved in one event will not be used to qualify a competitor for a different event.

4. **Results for Selection**

Only official final results from the 2026 TPA Action Pistol World Championships will be eligible for consideration. Competitors will not be required to submit those results separately, as TPA will automatically use the official published results for qualification, merit ranking, and tie-breaking.

5. Selection Process

Selection will be based on merit ranking determined as follows:

- a. Competitors will be ranked separately for each CMP World Championships competition according to their official result in the corresponding event at the 2026 TPA Action Pistol National Championships.
- b. In accordance with that merit ranking, competitors will be offered positions in each CMP World Championships competition.
- c. Competitors may be selected in more than one CMP World Championships competition where they qualify in more than one corresponding event.
- d. In the event of a tie for merit ranking, the official placing and tie-break outcome recorded in the published results for that event, including X count where applicable, will be considered.

6. Team offer and acceptance of a position on the Team

- a. TPA may formally offer each selected athlete a position in the relevant 2026 CMP World Championships competition. Acceptance of this offer must be submitted in writing to TPA within twelve (12) hours of the date and time of TPA's letter of offer, along with the signed TPA Team Agreement.
- b. Written notification of inability to accept a position must be received by TPA within twelve (12) hours of the date and time of TPA's letter of offer. In the event that a response is not received or the offer is declined, the position will be offered to the next-highest-ranked athlete who has qualified for selection in that competition until all positions are filled or no other qualifiers remain. In this instance, where the next highest-ranked athlete is offered a position, acceptance of this offer must be submitted in writing to TPA within twelve (12) hours of the date and time of TPA's letter of offer.
